On Friday, April 16, 2010 two informational sessions will be held for employees regarding Section 18A of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 32B. This law has been presented to and adopted by the City Council. The law requires retirees (Medicare-eligible retirees, spouses and dependents), who retire on or after July 1, 2010 to enroll in a Medicare supplemental plan (also called a "senior plan").

The informational sessions will be held at 1010 Massachusetts Avenue in the Hayes Conference Room, 2nd floor. The first session will begin at 2:00 p.m. and the second session will start at 3:00 p.m.
